Robertson back in spotlight

NEW YORK — A&E has declined to comment on new video of “Duck Dynasty” star **Phil Robertson** reviving past anti-gay remarks. His comments are included in a sermon delivered at his church in West Monroe, Louisiana, on Easter Sunday. Robertson includes homosexuals with other groups such as thieves and adulterers as hell-bound sinners. Robertson is the bearded patriarch of a clan that manufactures duck calls and became reality-TV stars. In December he set off a firestorm after GQ magazine quoted him linking homosexual behavior to bestiality. He also made racist statements.

Jay Z's music fest lineup set



NEW YORK — Jay Z has called close friend **Kanye West** to headline his Budweiser Made in America festival in Philadelphia. **Kings of Leon**, **Pharrell** and **Tiesto** also will play the two-day event over Labor Day weekend on the Benjamin Franklin Parkway. Jay Z will expand the festival with performances also in Los Angeles for the first time since its launch in 2012. **John Mayer**, **Imagine Dragons**, **Juanes**, **Kendrick Lamar**, **Afrojack** and **Weezer** will perform in Grand Park in Los Angeles.

Stones' biz manager dies

LONDON — He was the prince who helped make the Rolling Stones as rich as kings. **Prince Rupert Loewenstein**, Rolling Stones' former business manager, who helped the Stones churn their musical talent into mountains of gold. He died Tuesday at age 80 in a London hospital after suffering from Parkinson's disease, friend Hugo Vickers said Thursday.

Emanuel on with Fallon

CHICAGO — Mayor **Rahm Emanuel** is to appear on “The Tonight Show” with **Jimmy Fallon**, making good on his promise after the host came to Chicago in March and jumped into the icy Lake Michigan. The mayor's office and NBC officials said Thursday that Emanuel will appear on the show June 3.

McCartney recovering



NEW YORK — **Paul McCartney** has been treated for a virus that led him to cancel his tour in Japan. Publicist **Perri Cohen** said in a statement Thursday that McCartney received treatment at a hospital in Tokyo. Cohen adds that McCartney is expected to make a complete recovery and will be taking time to rest. McCartney cancelled his entire Out There Japan Tour 2014 this week because of the illness.

Leary donates to firefighters

DETROIT — **Denis Leary**, a longtime supporter of firefighters and the star of an acclaimed TV show in which he played one, was in Detroit on Thursday to present \$260,000 worth of equipment to the bankrupt city's fire department. The new gear was paid for by proceeds from “Burn,” a documentary film about the city's firefighters that Leary executive-produced.

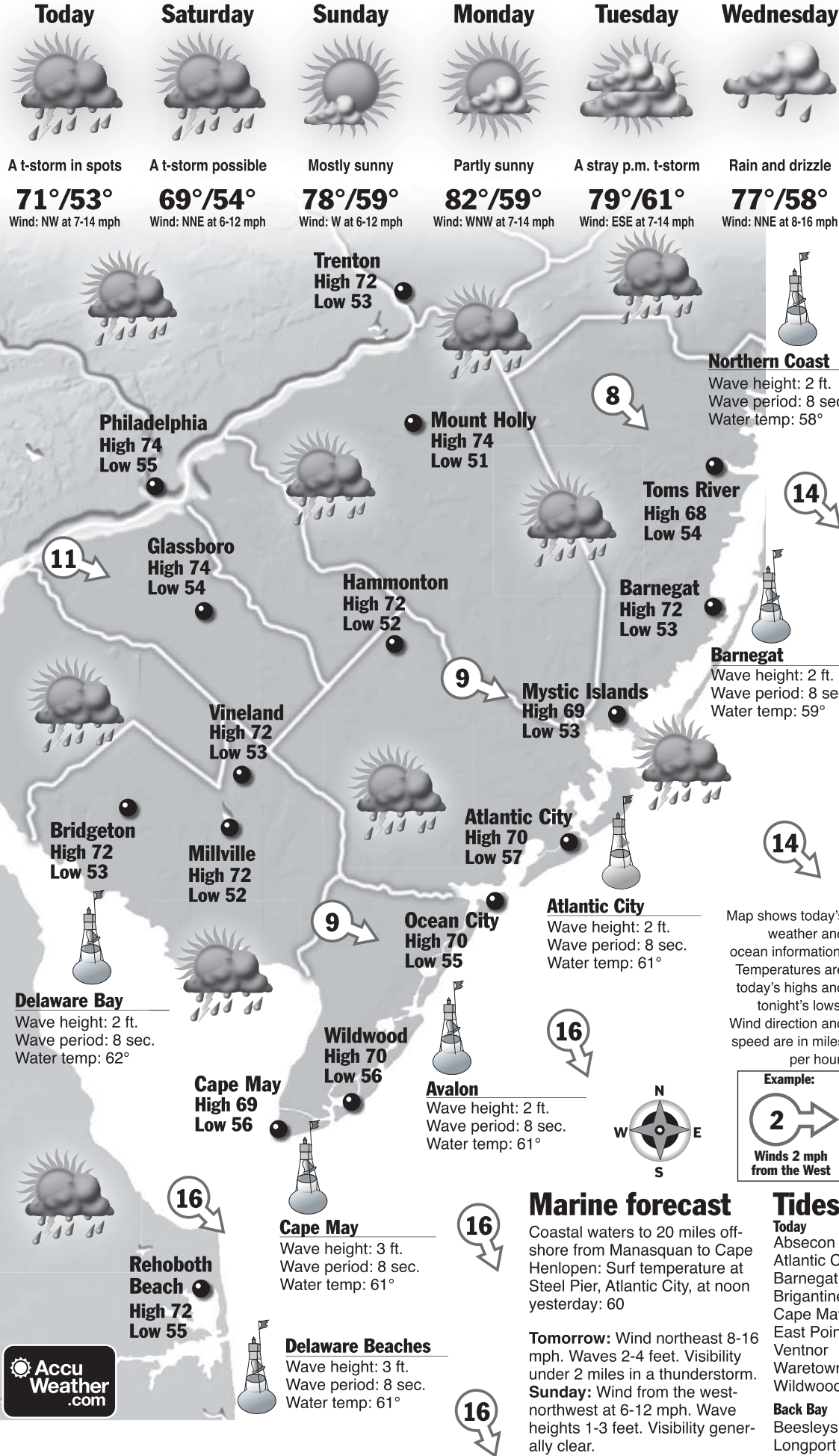

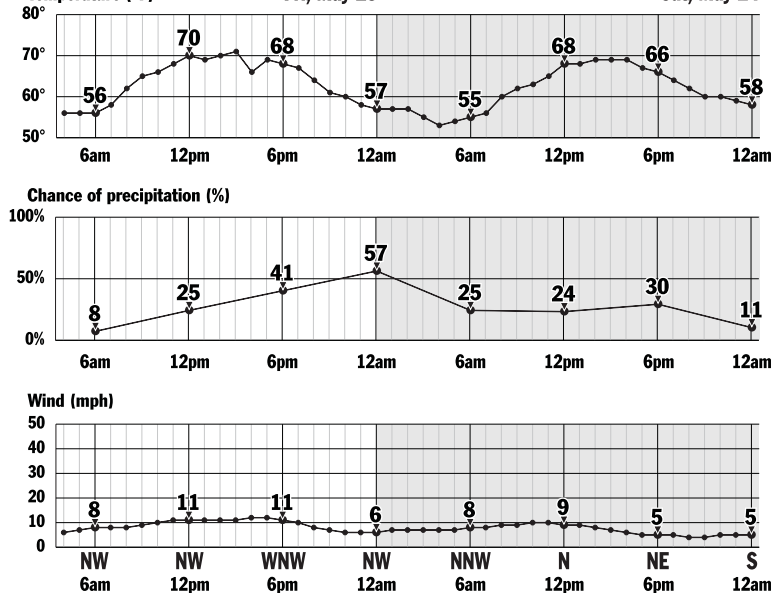

In 1934, bank robbers Clyde Barrow and Bonnie Parker were shot to death in a police ambush in Louisiana.
Other events:
■ In 1939, the Navy submarine USS Squalus sank during a test dive off the New England coast.
■ In 1967, Egypt closed the Straits of Tiran to Israeli ships, an action which precipitated war between Israel and its Arab neighbors the following month.
■ In 1984, Surgeon General C. Everett Koop issued a report saying there was “very solid” evidence linking cigarette smoke to lung disease in nonsmokers.
■ In 1994, ‘Mad Bomber’ George Metesky, who’d terrified New Yorkers more than 16 years, died in Connecticut at 90.
